# **5 Dangers of Untreated Varicose Veins**

The term "varicose" refers to swollen and twisty veins. A common misconception is that varicose veins and spider veins (the smallest versions of varicose veins) are mere cosmetic nuisances. Since the disease-producing varicose veins are deeper inside the legs, patients are sometimes confused when they can't see any ropy veins or spider veins.

Almost half of all adults have vein problems in their

legs and approximately a quarter have symptomatic

symptoms such as heaviness in the legs, tiredness,

varicose veins. When the veins in the legs fail

(become "varicose"), they initially cause mild

itching, and aching. Gradually, the persistent

pooling of blood in the diseased veins leads to

more debilitating symptoms such as leg cramps,

restless leg syndrome, burning sensation, and pain.

Symptoms tend to be worse at night after patients

have been on their feet during the day. Prolonged

sitting or standing, age, and genetic predisposition



# 5 Dangers of Untreated Varicose Veins

### **Blood Clots**

According to a recent study\* published in JAMA, varicose veins may be an early warning sign of potentially deadly blood clots. Patients with varicose veins were found to have over 5 times higher risk of DVT (Deep Vein Thrombosis). Those with varicose veins were also found to have a higher risk of PE (Pulmonary Embolism) where a clot from the leg may break loose and travel to the lungs as well as a higher risk of PAD (Peripheral Arterial Disease).

## **Tedema-Phiebolymphedema**

The increased pressure of blood pooled inside the varicose veins causes swelling (edema). Left untreated, the buildup of excessive fluid stresses the lymphatic system. When the lymphatic system fails, there is a further accumulation of protein-rich lymphatic fluid inside the leg and the condition is called phlebolymphedema. At this stage, the condition may be irreversible.

## **Bleeding**

Varicose veins cause increased pressure of blood in the leg veins and fragile skin over time. Terminal branches of veins are pushed closer to the skin surface; a perfect setup for profuse bleeding even from a slight scratch.

# Skin Infections (Cellulitis)

Skin Infection (cellulitis) is an infection of the skin and tissues beneath the skin. Compromised circulation and accumulation of excessive fluid due to varicose veins result in inflammation and breakdown of the skin resulting in cellulitis. Infection can then rapidly spread to other parts of the body causing blood infection (sepsis).


